let's TALK

1. *Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Mark 11:12-19, Isaiah 53:2-12 & Jeremiah 31:31-34. What strikes you as you read?*
2. **Where in your life is God's Word & His love bearing fruit? If it isn't, what would be necessary for that to happen? How does the cleansing of the Temple outer-courts shed light on what Jesus is trying to impress upon his followers (including us)?**
3. **Why would the religious leaders begin to plan to kill Jesus from this point forward? Why would this same event produce awe/amazement in the crowds & fear in the 12?**
4. **Why does God need to make a New Covenant, not like the Old Covenant, with His people? What is new about this New Covenant according to vs. 33-34? What is the same? Why will there be no need for "each one to teach his neighbor and each his brother" to "know the LORD"? How will this take place?**
5. **As a member of the New Covenant, how does knowing the difference between the Old & New Covenants help you to live in victory over sin? How does understanding the New Covenant aid you in growing in your love for Christ?**
6. **How does knowing God was continuously faithful to his rebellious people shape your view of your relationship with him when you fail/disobey/rebel?**
7. **How would you explain to someone what it means to be live in God's promises?**
