let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Acts 2:1-21. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. Have you ever tried to communicate with someone who didn't speak your language? What was that like? Jesus had promised his followers they would be his "witnesses" all over the world. How would the Spirit help them live that promise?
3. Why do you think the Spirit came with wind & tongues of fire? Compare verse 4 with Mark 13:9-11. How does Peter's sermon fulfill Jesus' promise?
4. Some people scoffed at the disciples when the Holy Spirit came upon them. Did that scoffing keep Peter & the others from telling others about Jesus? Why do you think that was so? How can the Spirit help you share Jesus' love?
5. What is significance of the disciples proclaiming "the mighty works of God" (v.11)? What does this reveal about the Holy Spirit's agenda? How do we know that the Holy Spirit is at work among us? How would you describe the Spirit's work in you?
6. What is the difference between the courageous Peter standing by Jesus in the Garden, the fearful Peter denying Jesus, & the bold Peter on Pentecost? How could that change occur in you? To whom can the Spirit send you this week.
