1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/low. Read Joshua 4:1-24. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. What are some monuments that memorialize historic events? How do these monuments capture the significance of the events? What are some positive events that have shaped you? How do you remind yourself of those events?
3. After they crossed the Jordan River, what were the Israelites told to do & why were they told to do it? What is the purpose of memorial markers like those stones? Do you have spiritual mementos like that? What purpose do they serve for you?
4. How do verses 6-7 fulfill the same purpose as Ex 12:24-28, Deut 6:4-9, Mt 26:20-28 & 1 Cor 11:23-26? Why is it important to hold on to the living memory of those things that remind us who we are as God's people? How does your family keep spiritual memories alive? Could you do better? What God-stories should your kids know?
5. Why is it important for all people on earth to know that the hand of the Lord is mighty? To "fear the Lord" is more than "to be frightened of." It implies reverence & awe in the presence of Him who grants you life to the full & love eternally freely in Christ.
