1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Joshua 7:1-8:2a. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. What was the reason the Israelites were defeated at Ai in their first attack? Describe Achan's progression from temptation to sin? How is that progression common in human experience as you know it? Does that describe you at times?
3. What was the required remedy? Why such a harsh response? Read Acts 5:1-11. How are these two different accounts very similar? How is self-interest & greed such a destructive force that it must be dealt with swiftly & definitively?
4. How does God's response to Israel's repentance encourage you? Why is it important to remind ourselves of God's forgiveness, as the Israelites did in this instance? How does our turning away from sin give glory to God?
5. What is one step you can take to restore or renew your commitment to obey the Lord? What is one practical way you could remind yourself of God's forgiveness?
6. Our sin often effects others. To whom do you need to offer your repentance so that your relationship might be restored & God's glory revealed?
