

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Joshua 23:14-16 & 24:14-15. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. This is Joshua's "farewell address." What is something you'd want to say to your closest family & friends before you die? Why that? What would you not say? Why?
3. Joshua reminds them & us "every promise of God has come true." Given that faithfulness, what might your response be? How faithful are you in your relationship with the Father?
4. Joshua offers both warnings & promises to Israel. Given what you know of their history, which path is the one they eventually follow? Does their faithfulness or lack of it determine God's ultimate intention for his people & this world? What confidence does that give you as a Christian? Does that give you a different outlook on life than other folks you know? Why/not?
5. Joshua openly declares the faith-filled path ahead for his family. What is the risk in being so public about his intention? What effect does he hope his public witness has on the rest of the tribes? Have you ever made such a public declaration of your faith in Jesus before? How do you openly witness to Christ among your friends?
