let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 13:24-30 & 36-43. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. What is our natural human tendency in the presence of people whom we find **difficult or hard to get along with? How is Jesus' plan better?**
3. Why does the owner of the field, the "householder," tell his slaves to let the wheat & weeds grow together? In Scripture "harvest" is a common metaphor for the time of God's judgment. Describe the destinies of the various products of the field. What is the difference between those two destinies? Who decides?
4. Compare this parable with 7:15-20. How are these 2 related? Why is this parable so puzzling for the disciples? Why is patience & forbearance toward unbelievers so difficult for them? For us?
5. What is Jesus saying here about: church purity? Divine patience? Human **accountability? What is God's ultimate answer to the problem of sin & unbelief?**
6. How can an overzealous judgment of the world & its evils actually do harm to the mission of the church? Have you ever seen that happen?
7. To whom do you need to exercise patience & love as you await the final harvest?
