let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 13:31-32. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. What is notable about mustard seeds with respect to the plant they grow into? In Matthew 17:14-21 Jesus used the mustard seed as an example of faith. Compare and contrast these two uses of the humble mustard seed?
3. **What is Jesus' intention for the church as it reflects the Kingdom if the plan is the "birds come and make nests in its branches."? Why would the disciples in particular need to understand a parable like this?**
4. **Our experience of the presence of God's Kingdom is often very small & almost unnoticeable.** How does something we sometimes take for granted become a movement that impacts the whole world? How is the presence & impact of the Kingdom being noticeably experienced in your life?
5. What promise and power is present in the Kingdom as it resides in each of us as **Christ's disciples? What are you doing to sow that seed with its promise and power** into the lives of people around you?
6. What encouragement do you find in this parable? How can we pray for you?
