COLOSSIANS 4:2-6

² Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart. ³ Pray for us, too, that God will give us many opportunities to speak about his mysterious plan concerning Christ. That is why I am here in chains. ⁴ Pray that I will proclaim this message as clearly as I should.

⁵ Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity. ⁶ Let your conversation be gracious and attractive so that you will have the right response for everyone.

PHILIPPIANS 4:4-7

⁴ Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! ⁵ Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon.

⁶ **Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything.** Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you **will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand.** His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

LUKE 18:1-8

One day Jesus told his disciples a story to show that they should always pray and never give up. ² **"There was a judge in a certain city,"** he said, **"who neither feared God nor cared about people."** ³ **A widow of that city came to him repeatedly, saying, 'Give me justice in this dispute with my enemy.'** ⁴ The judge ignored her for a while, but finally he said to himself, **'I don't fear God or care about people,**

⁵ **but this woman is driving me crazy. I'm going to see that she gets justice, because she is wearing me out with her constant requests!'"**

⁶ **Then the Lord said, "Learn a lesson from this unjust judge. Even he rendered a just decision in the end. So don't you think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who cry out to him day and night? Will he keep putting them off?"**

⁸ **I tell you, he will grant justice to them quickly! But when the Son of Man returns, how many will he find on the earth who have faith?"**
