let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Philippians 3. What strikes you as you read?
2. Paul warns the church in vss. 2-3 against what group of people? Who would be **most impressed by Paul's spiritual pedigree in vss. 5-6?** Why does Paul now **consider this "pedigree" "worthless/garbage?"** What is of **infinite value to him?**
3. Paul is stirred up as he writes. What he says is at the very core of his identity in Christ. Paul contrasts two approaches to righteousness. How is each obtained?
4. In vss. 10-11, Paul lists four intense desires. What are they? How are they obtained? Paul desired to become like Jesus in his death (vs. 10). How does this desire affect his obedience to Christ regarding what he is facing in prison at Rome?
5. **What might Jesus call you to "lose" so that you can enjoy a more full relationship with him?** What difference is it likely to make in our present conduct if we see ourselves as citizens of heaven? How does that impact our current circumstances?
6. In vss. 16-19, Paul distinguishes between some fake believers & true followers of Christ. What are the characteristics of these fake believers? How are we different?
7. How is vs 21 a comfort, encouragement and assurance for you right now? With whom can you share that this week?
