Romans 12:1-2

*And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. <sup>2</sup> **Don't copy the behaviour and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. **Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.*****

1 Chronicles 16:23-39

<sup>23</sup> *Let the whole earth sing to the Lord! Each day proclaim the good news that he saves. <sup>24</sup> Publish his glorious deeds among the nations. Tell everyone about the amazing things he does. <sup>25</sup> Great is the Lord! He is most worthy of praise! He is to be feared above all gods. <sup>26</sup> The gods of other nations are mere idols, but the Lord made the heavens! <sup>27</sup> Honour and majesty surround him; strength and joy fill his dwelling. <sup>28</sup> O nations of the world, recognize the Lord, recognize that the Lord is glorious and strong. <sup>29</sup> Give to the Lord the glory he deserves! Bring your offering and come into his presence. Worship the Lord in all his holy splendour. <sup>30</sup> Let all the earth tremble before him. The world stands firm and cannot be shaken. <sup>31</sup> Let the heavens be glad, and the earth rejoice! Tell **all the nations, "The Lord reigns!"** <sup>32</sup> Let the sea and everything in it shout his praise! Let the fields and their crops burst out with joy! <sup>33</sup> Let the trees of the forest sing for joy before the Lord, for he is coming to judge the earth. <sup>34</sup> Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever. <sup>35</sup> **Cry out, "Save us, O God of our salvation! Gather and rescue us from among the nations, so we can thank your holy name and rejoice and praise you."** <sup>36</sup> Praise the Lord, the God of Israel, who lives **from everlasting to everlasting! And all the people shouted "Amen!"** and praised the Lord. <sup>37</sup> David arranged for Asaph and his fellow Levites to **serve regularly before the Ark of the Lord's Covenant, doing whatever needed to be done each day.** <sup>38</sup> This group included Obed-edom (son of Jeduthun), Hosah, and sixty-eight other Levites as gatekeepers. <sup>39</sup> Meanwhile, David stationed Zadok the priest and his fellow priests at the Tabernacle of the Lord at the place of worship in Gibeon, where they continued to minister before the Lord.*
