let's TALK

- 1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Isaiah 9:2-7 & Luke 21:25-36. What strikes you as you read?
- 2. Where are 9:1-2 quoted in the New Testament? What hints does this give as to how this promise was interpreted? What blessing is promised in vv 3-5?
- 3. Read Isaiah 9:2 & John 8:12. What does it mean to say that Jesus is the light of the world? Isaiah 9:2 is a promise to the people that their troubles will come to an end. How do you think hearing v2 might have helped the people during captivity?
- 4. Read 2 Corinthians 4:6. Where does the Bible tell us that the light of Jesus needs to shine, and do you know why this is?
- 5. Look at the extended "naming" of Jesus. How does he carry out those varied roles?
- 6. In v7, we start to find out what it will be like for Jesus to be King. What do you find?
- 7. "What does it mean that Jesus is our Wonderful Counselor (Isaiah 9:6)?"
- 8. What is the significance of Deity "coming" in clouds in the following passages: Isaiah 19:1; Psalms 18:9-14; 104:3; ? Do any of these count as Jesus' 2nd coming?
- 9. **Note Jesus' imperatives. What is His main concern for His hearers in terms of** application? Jesus gives a final warning. What is the warning? What kind of attitude does Jesus describe concerning His return? How do you fit that description?
