let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-14 & Luke 5:1-11. What strikes you as you read?
2. **What's something you've worked hard at but had no result to show for your effort?** How do you feel when that happens? What do you do?
3. What are some of your normal family routines? How many do you do without thinking? What would it take to change those routines? How would you feel?
4. Why was Peter reluctant to do what Jesus said? Have you ever been hesitant to obey Jesus because you have previously failed? What was different this time, both **about Jesus' command, & the results of Peter's obedience?**
5. **What is significant about Peter's response to the overwhelming catch of fish and his response to the call to "fish for people"?** What does "fish for people" mean to you?
6. In what area of your life might Jesus be calling you to go deeper in your relationship with him? Going deeper can be scary. What scares you about going deeper in your walk with Jesus? Who is someone you want to call to go with you?
7. Discuss: **"If a church's strategy is not grounded in making disciples, the church has abandoned the mission Christ has given."** *Ordinary Radicals: A Return to Christ-Centered Discipleship* So...How are you living out the call to fish for people & make disciples?
