let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 6:17-23 and then 24-26. What strikes you as you read?
2. **Why do you think this encounter with Jesus begins with Jesus healing "everyone?"** How is his healing & restorative work linked to what he says here?
3. **How would you define "blessed?" Do you often feel like you are blessed? Why/not?** Are you pretty comfortable with where you are spiritually? Why/not?
4. What is wrong with being rich? With desiring to be rich? Why is this such a stumbling block for us?
5. **Do you know people you don't share your faith with because you are afraid they will distance themselves from you? Why are you concerned about the opinion of someone who will spend eternity separated from God?**
6. In this Sermon (& its partner in Matthew 5) Jesus describes the worldview, outlook, or perspective of a disciple in the arms of grace. How is this different from what you encounter in the world? What would a contemporary TV show do to depict the **world's value system over against that of Jesus?**
7. How is knowing you are blessed by God despite the outward circumstances of your life a comfort & source of hope? With whom can you share that hope & comfort?
