

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 6:43-45 & Colossians 2:6-7. What strikes you as you read?
2. How do people ultimately know about the state of our hearts? What is the best evidence you can give to someone else that you are a follower of Jesus?
3. Compare verses 41-42 with verses 43-45 AND verses 46-49. How do these 3 sets of verses relate to or help explain one another?
4. What did Jesus say is the source of good & evil things in someone's life? How is a person's heart transformed? What in your heart needs to be changed by Christ?
5. Why does Paul refer to our being "rooted & built on" Christ? What does this suggest to you? Is Paul concerned that the church has full assurance of their salvation, or is there something else on his mind?
6. How has your understanding of "life in Christ" changed over the course of your life?
7. How is "thankfulness" a direct result of a growing relationship TO & a growing life IN Christ? How does your life reflect that thankfulness & that growth? What would be helpful to you in growing you more effectively?
8. Note Paul's repeated warnings: vs 4, 8, 16, & 18. What warnings would he give you and how can we pray for you to be kept firm in faith & growing in Christ?
