1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 10:1-11. What strikes you as you read?
2. What's a seemingly impossible task in your life that you have been asked to do? What happened or is happening as a result?
3. Think for a bit on the word "harvest." Jesus send us to "harvest." How does that change your perspective on your work of sharing the grace & love of God with others? Who is doing all the preparation?
4. What do you notice about how Jesus sends his followers? What advantages or disadvantages do you see? How does Jesus provide for those who bear his name and reveal his kingdom to the world? What is the one thing they are told to pray for?
5. What do you think it means to say "the Kingdom of God is near"?
6. How does announcing that a different set of rules, a new way of life, a manner of living unlike what is typically seen in the world is now possible, cause you to be a target from those around you while at the same time being an attraction to others?
7. Jesus promises that wherever he sends us, he is going to go too. How does that give you confidence to obey? Where and to whom do you believe Jesus is sending you and a companion today?
