1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 24:1-12 & Colossians 1:15-22. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. Why do the women go to the tomb? What were they expecting? What was their first thought when they saw the tomb? Given what Jesus had said while he was alive, should they have expected the empty tomb? Why were they confused? Why were the male disciples so skeptical & un-believing?
3. Since there were no eyewitnesses to the actual resurrection, what sorts of evidence would you point to as proof of Jesus' being raised from the dead?
4. Read Rom. 6:1-11. According to these verses what becomes possible for believers as a result of Jesus' resurrection? How is this possible?
5. How would you answer someone who asked; "Why is Easter such a big deal?"
6. In what ways could the resurrection of Jesus be a source of renewal & hope for you on a daily basis?
7. Who is someone you can share your hope in Christ with this week?
