## let's TALK

1. *Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Revelation 21:1-7 & 22:1-7, 12-20. What strikes you as you read?*
2. What do you look forward to most in expectation of the New Creation & fulfillment of **God's Kingdom? How might 21:3-5** be the pinnacle of your expectation?
3. In what sense is the Church the "bride" of Christ? (see also Is. 54:5-8; Hos. 2:14-20) What is the significance of a bride prepared for her husband? Why does it matter so **much that God's chooses to dwell with us to be our God?**
4. How is Revelation 22:1-6 similar to the garden of Eden? What is different from the garden of Eden? Why is that important? Compare John 4:13-14 & John 7:37-39 with Rev. 22:1-2. What event stands between the original promises & their being kept that you hold to for hope & assurance?
5. **The final arrival of God's kingdom is noted both by what is present AND by what is absent.** What do you believe will matter most, that which is present or the absent?
6. Jesus repeatedly says, **"I am coming soon."** How should this impact the way we live **as his disciples? Do you regularly pray with serious intent, "Come Lord Jesus"?**
