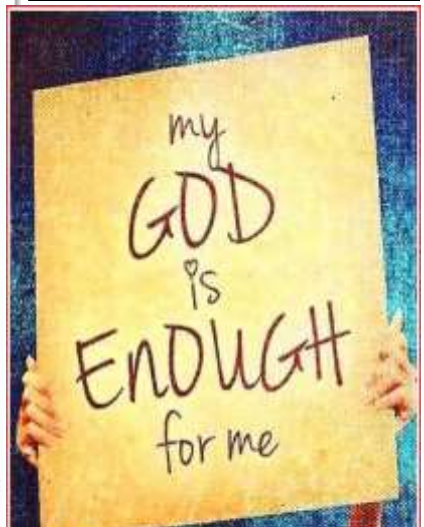

Bible Readings for today

HABAKKUK 1:1-5

This is the message that the prophet Habakkuk received in a vision.

² How long, O Lord, must I call for help? But you do not listen!

***“Violence is everywhere!” I cry, but you do not come to save.** ³ Must I forever see these evil deeds? Why must I watch all this misery?*

Wherever I look, I see destruction and violence. I am surrounded by people who love to argue and fight. ⁴ The law has become paralyzed, and there is no justice in the courts. The wicked far outnumber the righteous, so that justice has become perverted. ⁵ The Lord replied,

“Look around at the nations; look and be amazed! For I am doing something in your own day, something you wouldn’t believe even if someone told you about it.

HABAKKUK 2:1-4 & 18-20

*I will climb up to my watchtower and stand at my guardpost. There I will wait to see what the Lord says and how he will answer my complaint. ² **Then the Lord said to me, “Write my answer plainly on tablets, so that a runner can carry the correct message to others.***

*³ This vision is for a future time. It describes the end, and it will be fulfilled. If it seems slow in coming, wait patiently, for it will surely take place. It will not be delayed. ⁴ **“Look at the proud! They trust in themselves, and their lives are crooked. But the righteous will live by their faithfulness to God.***

*¹⁸ **“What good is an idol carved by man, or a cast image that deceives you? How foolish to trust in your own creation—a god that can’t even talk! ¹⁹ What sorrow awaits you who say to wooden idols, ‘Wake up and save us!’ To speechless stone images you say, ‘Rise up and teach us!’ Can an idol tell you what to do? They may be overlaid with gold and silver, but they are lifeless inside. ²⁰ But the Lord is in his holy Temple. Let all the earth be silent before him.”***
