## let's TALK

1. *Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Habakkuk 3. What strikes you as you read?*
2. What is it about God that causes Habakkuk to be filled with awe? (some translations say "fear") **Are you often awestruck before God? When? Or Why not?**
3. **Habakkuk knows his people deserve God's punishment, but he also wants God to remember what essential character trait that God's people depend upon? Why that one?** How does that reveal the true nature of the Father?
4. What historical event does Habakkuk recall in chapter 3? Why is that part of his prophecy? Compare vss 8-10 with Ps 74:12-17 & 77:16-19. What similarities do you see? **Why would these be part of Habakkuk's recalling of God's mighty deeds?**
5. **How can recalling God's grace to you in the past be a source of hope & strength in the midst of current trouble? Can you recount God's goodness to you to offer that same hope to someone else?**
6. Do you really trust God to work for you in the midst of the unfinished business of grief, heartache, illness or distress? Can you offer that hope to someone else?
