let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows.
Read Isaiah 2:2-4, John 18:33-37 & Luke 11:1-4. What strikes you as you read?
2. **Why does Pilate ask about Jesus' "kingship" not his guilt or innocence? How is Jesus' answer a different kind of confrontation than Pilate may have expected? Why has Jesus been taken to Pilate in the first place? (read vs 30-32 if you're not sure)**
3. What do you believe are the crucial differences between the kingdoms that ARE of this world, and the Kingdom of God? How does your life reflect one or the other? If someone simply observed you, which kingdom would they see most frequently?
4. **In Isaiah's vision, what is most captivating to you? When Isaiah sees all nations drawn to God, what happens? How is this different from what we often expect to see when the "last days" arrive? How is this end fitting and consistent with the vision Jesus presents of the kingdom throughout his ministry? Can you give a few examples that highlight this sort of destiny in the Father's presence?**
5. **The 65 words of the Lord's Prayer are the most spoken words in the Bible. Pray this prayer every day this week, & share your experience with someone you know.**
