let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 6:9-13 & 25-34 and Philippians 4:10-20. What strikes you as you read?
2. Would your friends consider you a grateful person? Why/why not? Why does cynicism prevent thankfulness? How can deliberate generous acts of sharing add to gratefulness & thwart a cynical spirit?
3. How does a consistent daily prayer life cultivate a day-by-day reliance on & trust in **the Father, as well as thankfulness for what he's already given? Do you find it hard or easy to bring ALL your needs to God? Why do you think it is that way for you? When you pray about your needs, do you go straight to requests, or do you pray first about God's Kingdom & will being done? How does this part of the Lord's Prayer defend us from greed, covetousness & anxiety about our possessions?**
4. This week, every day of the week, write down 5 DIFFERENT things for which you are **thankful. Share that list of "thanksgivings" with someone who is not part of the church** being ready to explain how each item on the list is a gift to you from God.
