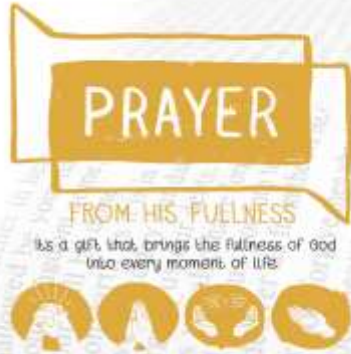

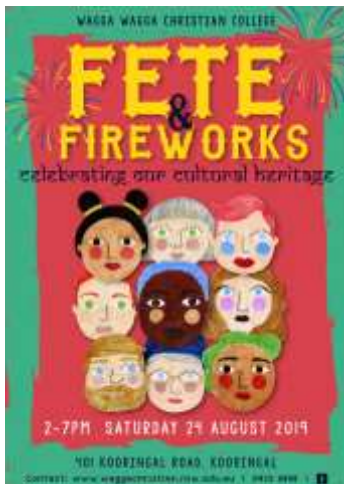

Bible Readings for today

MALACHI 3:1-4, 6-12 AND 4:1-6

“Look! I am sending my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me. Then the Lord you are seeking will suddenly come to his Temple. The messenger of the covenant, whom you look for so eagerly, is surely coming,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. ⁴ Then once more the Lord will accept the offerings brought to him by the people of Judah and Jerusalem, as he did in the past. ⁶ ***“I am the Lord, and I do not change. That is why you descendants of Jacob are not already destroyed.*** ⁷ Ever since the days of your ancestors, you have scorned my decrees ***and failed to obey them. Now return to me, and I will return to you,”*** says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. ***“But you ask, ‘How can we return when we have never gone away?’*** ⁸ ***“Should people cheat God? Yet you have cheated me! “But you ask, ‘What do you mean? When did we ever cheat you?’ “You have cheated me of the tithes and offerings due to me.*** ⁹ You are under a curse, for your whole nation has been cheating me. ¹⁰ Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be ***enough food in my Temple. If you do,”*** says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, ***“I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won’t have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test! “Your crops will be abundant, for I will guard them from insects and disease. Your grapes will not fall from the vine before they are ripe,”*** says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies.

¹² ***“Then all nations will call you blessed, for your land will be such a delight,”*** says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. ⁴ The Lord of Heaven’s Armies says, ***“The day of judgment is coming, burning like a furnace. On that day the arrogant and the wicked will be burned up like straw. They will be consumed—roots, branches, and all.*** ² ***“But for you who fear my name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in his wings. And you will go free, leaping with joy like calves let out to pasture.*** ³ On the day when I act, you will tread upon the wicked as if they were ***dust under your feet,”*** says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies. ⁴ ***“Remember to obey the Law of Moses, my servant—all the decrees and regulations that I gave him on Mount Sinai for all Israel.*** ⁵ ***“Look, I am sending you the prophet Elijah before the great and dreadful day of the Lord arrives.*** ⁶ His preaching will turn the hearts of fathers to their children, and the hearts of children to their fathers. ***Otherwise I will come and strike the land with a curse.”***

Parents are reminded that they are responsible for the supervision of their children before and after church.
