## let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 6:9-13, Psalm 32:8-11 and Luke 4:1-13. What strikes you as you read?
2. **Describe Jesus' physical & spiritual condition at the time of his temptation? What warning does that raise for you? Do you think that Satan waits until we are weak to attack us? Why/Why not? When might we be most vulnerable?**
3. Read Hebrews 5:5-9. What is another reason that Jesus was tempted? How does the temptation relate to our salvation? How does Jesus respond to Satan? What does Jesus demonstrate about faith through his being tempted? What are some ways we are tempted to put our goals & desires ahead of God?
4. What are some means of spiritual deception that Satan sometimes uses? How did he attempt that with Jesus? Why do people struggle with blaming God when they are tempted? What role does God play in your temptations? Why do you think **Jesus teaches us to pray "lead us not into temptation"?** **With whom can you share that strength in all times from the Father?**
