let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 6:9-13, Psalm 121 and John 17:6-12. What strikes you as you read?
2. What reassurance is it to you that God keeps you & watches over you? When you read Psalm 121, how do you feel?
3. **Followers of Jesus aren't immune to accident, persecution, or death. How do you understand God's promised protection? In what ways does God really protect us?**
4. **What is Jesus' concern in vs 11-12? How does Jn 16:33 also address this concern?**
5. **Notice that Jesus' prayer for his disciples involves both long-term & short-term needs. Do you pray for those around you in that same long-term/short-term way?**
6. How do you daily address the presence & persistence of the evil one? Where do you find evil to be most at work in your awareness? How do you defend against evil?
7. **What do you find encouraging in Jesus' prayer for his followers? Take note of how we are "given" to him by the Father & always claimed in the Father's grace. In what ways can you share that assurance with someone else this week?**
