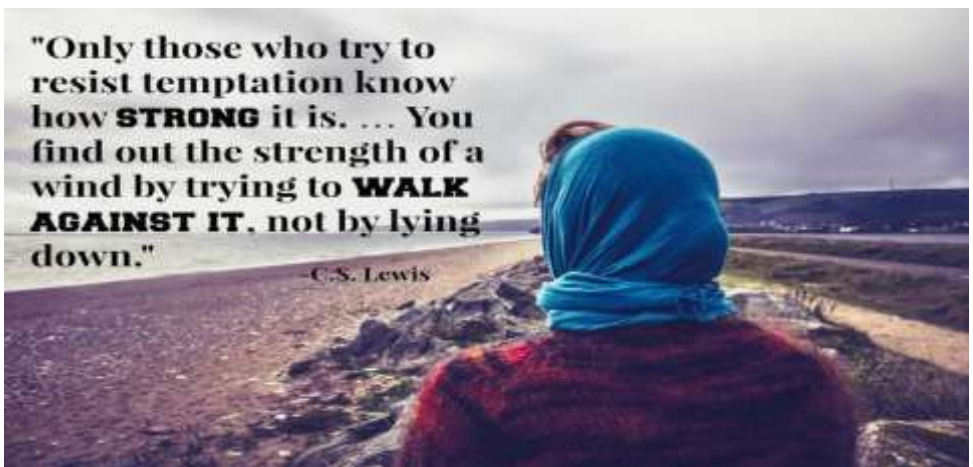

## Bible Readings for today ....

PSALM 32:8-11

<sup>8</sup> **The Lord says, "I will guide you along the best pathway for your life. I will advise you and watch over you. <sup>9</sup> Do not be like a senseless horse or mule that needs a bit and bridle to keep it under control."** <sup>10</sup> Many sorrows come to the wicked, but unfailing love surrounds those who trust the Lord. <sup>11</sup> So rejoice in the Lord and be glad, all you who obey him! Shout for joy, all you whose hearts are pure!

MATTHEW 6:9-13 (ESV)

<sup>9</sup> **Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. <sup>10</sup> Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. <sup>11</sup> Give us this day our daily bread, <sup>12</sup> and forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. <sup>13</sup> And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.**

LUKE 4:1-13

Then Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan River. He was led by the Spirit in the wilderness, <sup>2</sup> where he was tempted by the devil for forty days. Jesus ate nothing all that time and became very hungry. <sup>3</sup> **Then the devil said to him, "If you are the Son of God, tell this stone to become a loaf of bread."** <sup>4</sup> **But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say, 'People do not live by bread alone.'" <sup>5</sup> Then the devil took him up and revealed to him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. <sup>6</sup> "I will give you the glory of these kingdoms and authority over them," the devil said, "because they are mine to give to anyone I please. <sup>7</sup> I will give it all to you if you will worship me." <sup>8</sup> Jesus replied, "The Scriptures say, 'You must worship the Lord your God and serve only him.'" <sup>9</sup> Then the devil took him to Jerusalem, to the highest point of the Temple, and said, "If you are the Son of God, jump off! <sup>10</sup> For the Scriptures say, 'He will order his angels to protect and guard you. <sup>11</sup> And they will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone.'" <sup>12</sup> Jesus responded, "The Scriptures also say, 'You must not test the Lord your God.'" <sup>13</sup> When the devil had finished tempting Jesus, he left him until the next opportunity came.**
