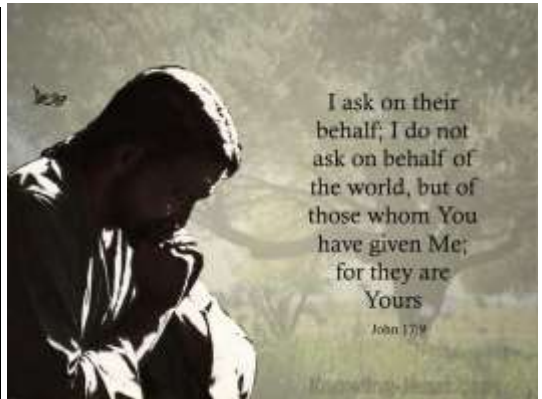

¹ I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from?
² My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. ³ He will not let your foot slip — he who watches over you will not slumber;
⁴ indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. ⁵ The Lord watches over you — the Lord is your shade at your right hand; ⁶ the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. ⁷ The Lord will keep you from all harm — he will watch over your life; ⁸ the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.

⁹ **Pray then like this: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.**

⁶ **“I have revealed you to the ones you gave me from this world. They** were always yours. You gave them to me, and they have kept your word.
⁷ Now they know that everything I have is a gift from you, ⁸ for I have passed on to them the message you gave me. They accepted it and know that I came from you, and they believe you sent me. ⁹ **“My prayer is not** for the world, but for those you have given me, because they belong to you. ¹⁰ All who are mine belong to you, and you have given them to me, so they bring me glory. ¹¹ Now I am departing from the world; they are staying in this world, but I am coming to you. Holy Father, you have given me your name; now protect them by the power of your name so that they will be united just as we are. ¹² During my time here, I protected them by the power of the name you gave me. I guarded them so that not one was lost, except the one headed for destruction, as the Scriptures foretold.
