let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 3:27-20 and Hosea 2:16-20. What strikes you as you read?
2. **In the ancient near east, a wife often referred to her husband as "master." What is significant about the shift God promises in Hos 2:16? Note all the "I will" promises God makes to his wayward people. Which is most important in your view?**
3. Read Isaiah 54:4-8. How does this promise compare with the one in Hosea? Vss 19-20 are better translated to repeat 3 times "I will make you my wife." **We remember that Hosea's wife had been unfaithful to him as God's people have been unfaithful in their relationship with God. What is the force of the repeated "marriage vow"? How do you feel knowing God is committed to you with such strength & determination?**
4. Looking at the image of marriage, how would you describe your current marriage relationship with God? In what ways could you be more faithful?
5. What do John means when he says, "He must become greater & greater and I must become less & less."? **How is this our goal for our lives? What do people see when they look at you: You or Jesus? What difference does this make?**
