1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 11:1-4, 17-27 & 32-44, Genesis 50:15-20 and Romans 8:28-39. What strikes you as you read?
2. How have you been shaped by God? What was that like? How did it feel? How did you know it was God? What has your refining process been like? Have you grown in more the face of tragedy & misfortune or through success & achievement? Why do you believe that is so?
3. How has God shaped your character? Did you recognize it as it happened? How was suffering & adversity part of that process? Are you tempted to blame God for tragedy or misfortune?
4. If God loves us enough to send his Son to the cross for us, we can be assured that God will give us all that we need, & will never leave us or forsake us. Which of the Scripture passages above help you claim that assurance? Why?
5. Can you share that assurance with someone you know who is experiencing a **difficult season in their life without saying something God doesn't say?**
