1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 1 Peter 1:13-25 & Matthew 28:1-10. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. What is the historical situation for Peter's 1st century readers? Why does vs 13 begin with "therefore" or "so," depending on your translation? What does Peter suggest is their biggest threat & how does his letter help them triumph over it?
3. What does it mean for you to know you are "holy," "set apart for God's purpose"? When Peter reminds his readers that God is the One who will judge, how is that an encouragement for them?
4. How is attentiveness & responsiveness to God's word a blessing? How have you experienced the blessing of that kind of obedience? How could you invite someone who does not yet trust Jesus as Lord & Saviour to do so based on your experience?
5. Which commands in vss 13-25 do you find most difficult? Why do you think that is? Note the similarity of vs 22 to John 13:34-35. How does Jesus help us to keep that command? With whom this week, do you need to be obedient to that command?
