1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 1 Peter 2:1-12 & Mark 16:1-8. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. On what basis can Peter give the command of verse 1? If we're all forgiven, why does it make a difference how we live our daily lives? (read Rom 6:1-14 for help) Are the listed behaviours primarily attitudes or actions? Does it matter in the long run?
3. Is it possible to stop conforming to the world's beliefs, assumptions & habits? How?
4. Compare Gal. 5:16-26 with what you read here. Peter & Paul describe the spiritual war in which we are all engaged at some level. How does that reality impact you?
5. Peter's images are collective: we are not just individuals, we are living stones, priests, chosen people. How does Living Water reflect this fact? Can you do that by yourself? Why?/Why not? What makes it possible for us to obey God's commands, particularly his command to love one another?
6. Read vs 12. What is our best witness to an unbelieving neighbour? What help can your faith community provide so that your words & deeds reveal Christ in you?
