1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Acts 2:1-21. What strikes you as you read? (Please also read John 20:19-23)
2. In John 20, Jesus grants his Spirit as an antidote to the disciples' fear. How is the Spirit a defense against fear? How is it helping you in our current circumstances?
3. Describe a time in the last year when you experienced God's presence in a real & personal way? How have you responded to that experience?
4. How do you witness the Holy Spirit working in your life & the life of the Church? What holds us back from seeing God's working in the lives of others or in our city?
5. How can the Spirit inspire us as we live in this confused & unsettled time? What message do you believe the Spirit would have Peter deliver to the mockers & sceptics in our world? How might you deliver that word from God?
6. Jesus promised his followers they would be his "witnesses" all over the world. How was the Spirit a gift that would help them live out that promise? How can the Spirit help you share Jesus' love with boldness & urgency? Who needs to hear from you, in a language they can understand, "the wonderful things God has done" in Jesus?
