## let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Ruth chapter 2. What strikes you as you read?
2. Do you see God's actively at work here or do you see the events as coincidences? Despite Naomi's plight, how do you see God's provision in the opening verses of Ruth 2? How have you seen God at work in your life when you faced bleak circumstances? How did you respond? What happened?
3. Ruth, without knowing it, is being observed as she gleanes. (vs.6-7) Boaz's servant reports to Boaz the basics of Ruth's situation. As Christians, we too are visible to others. How would someone report on your character like they did Ruth's? What would you do today for a stranger to note well your Christlikeness?
4. Previously Naomi said God was acting against her. What has changed? How?
5. Boaz's favour & generosity towards Ruth is startling. Read Luke 6:38. How is that promise fulfilled for Ruth?
6. How convinced are you that God wants to be involved in your life to accomplish his purposes & plans? How did you reach your conclusion? Given the knowledge that God DOES want to use your life for his glory, what are you going to do today?
