let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Ruth chapter 3. What strikes you as you read?
2. Ruth went alone at night to the threshing floor, where women would not usually go. How do you think she felt doing so? What does this show you about Ruth's bold obedience & faithfulness to Naomi & her pledge to Yahweh?
3. To lie/sit at someone's feet is to take the position of a servant, waiting for the word of the master. Read Lk 10:38-42. How is this encounter similar? What does this imply about Ruth's character & her expectation of Boaz? (compare with Mary & Jesus)
4. How has Naomi been transformed since Ruth 1 where she felt only bitterness? What has changed her? Note Philippians 2:13 & 2 Thessalonians 1:11 for insight.
5. What does the fact that Boaz did not pursue a relationship with Ruth, other than providing for her needs, reveal about his character? Are you willing to be patient & let God move in your life according to his timing? What keeps you from doing that?
6. Ruth took a risk. She took a step of faith to do what she felt God leading her to do. Where do you feel God is calling you to take a risk in faith now? What leading from God have you previously ignored that you now have a chance to obey?
