let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Ruth chapter 4. What strikes you as you read?
2. What do you do when God's plans for your life take a strange or unexpected turn? Do you trust him, or question him?
3. When we looked at Elimelech & his sons we talked about how the choices we make effect our future. What choices do the other kinsman & Boaz make? What difference does that make to their futures? Is it notable that we only know one of their names?
4. What did Naomi think God had done when she saw herself as “empty” & “bitter?” What part does she now see God playing? Has God changed? What's different?
5. Read Genesis 29 & 38. Who are Rachel & Leah and Tamar & Perez? What is significant about these people such that they are mentioned here? These are unusual accounts in the life of God's people, but God still worked in them. What does that say about you & the unusual circumstances in your life?
6. What does the book of Ruth reveal to us about the character of God? How does the book of Ruth encourage you to see God at work in your life? With whom can you share that discovery this week for their encouragement?
