## let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 10:38-42. Psalm 19:7-11 What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. Read Luke 9:51-62 for the background of why Jesus is at the sisters' home? Why do you think Luke included this story in his Gospel narrative? Why do you think Martha was so focused on her tasks? Is serving others wholeheartedly a bad thing? What good thing was Martha doing? What might be the issue here?
3. What else does sitting at his feet imply? Is it just learning or something more?
4. What happens when we compare ourselves with others? Do you feel like you are “worried & upset over many things”? Jesus invites us to see him as our ‘one thing.’ What other “things” draw your attention & devotion apart from Christ?
5. How do our choices often play out differently than we think? Have you ever made choices that complicated your life more than you expected? What did you do?
6. How would you like to grow your relationship with Jesus? What steps can you make? What would it look like to submit a greater portion of your life, family, job, ministry, etc., to the authority of Jesus? What changes would you make? With whom would you share your desire & efforts? What do you think would happen?
