let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Acts 2:42-47 & John 13:31-35. What strikes you as you read these verses?
2. Share a time you experienced a positive community (eg sports team, family, church) What are some of the joys of being part of a community? What are some risks?
3. What kind of impact do you think this pattern of teaching, fellowship, bread-breaking & prayer made on the people seeing this emerging movement. What do you think their reactions might have been?
4. Look at verse 42. What are the marks of the Church here. What are the risks to the local church if any of these are absent? “Fellowship” (koinōnia) is more than a shared meal or morning tea. It is a recognized closeness where people share life & contribute to the cause of Christ. In the early church, Jesus was the central reason for their gathering. How much time do you spend time with others where Jesus is the central reason for meeting?
5. What do you think people notice most about your life? ...about Living Water? What effect did true koinōnia have on those who were watching but not yet believers in Christ (v. 47)? On whom would you like to have that effect? Pray & live for it daily with other believers.
