let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Jude 1:1-4. What strikes you in these verses? How are they a challenge AND an encouragement for you?
2. Have you ever seen someone get “mates rates”? What was that like? If you were related to someone rich or famous, how could you use that relationship to your advantage? Why do you think neither Jude nor James do that when they write?
3. Can you share a time when you had a faith crisis or something happened in your life that dramatically challenged & shaped your faith? Who are some people that you admire who seem to have really strong faith? What do you think helped them be that way? How are you learning from them?
4. How have the false teachers entered the church to whom Jude writes? What is notable about the words he uses? How do you decide which leader to follow or on whom you will pattern your life as an imitation?
5. What current issues would cause you to “contend for/defend” the faith by which you live? What are some issues where you may disagree with a current understanding, but are also happy to allow some freedom of thought? How can you use that arena of Christian liberty as an opportunity to share the unchanging truth of Jesus?
