let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 19:1-10 & John 20:30-31. What strikes you in these verses? How are they a challenge AND an encouragement for you?
2. Why didn't Jesus say anything about money, sin, or the need to repent when he first spoke to Zacchaeus? If he had, do you think that would have altered Zacchaeus' response? Why do you think Zacchaeus received him joyfully? Read verse 6-7 again & notice the contrast between them. What can we learn from the contrast? Do you think vss 9-10 stop the crowd's complaining? Why/not?
3. Why do you think Zacchaeus voluntarily made such a generous restitution to those he had wronged? How are you different because of Christ's generous seeking & saving love towards you? How do you think Zacchaeus' self-image has changed?
4. Compare Zacchaeus with the man in Lk 18:18-30. What's different? What do you think accounts for that? Why does Jesus decide he wants to eat with Zacchaeus?
5. Jesus is going to Jericho & ultimately to Jerusalem to die/rise. Was Zacchaeus an interruption in his journey or the point for it? How do you know? Who are you in Jesus' journey? How do you feel about that? How can you share that with someone you know this week? How can we pray for you?
