

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read John 20:30-21:19. What strikes you as you read?
2. Why do you think the disciples went fishing? Why does Jesus interrupt this brief interlude in their lives? If there were no resurrection, Peter might have gone back to fishing full time. In what ways does the resurrection impact your daily life?
3. Read Jn 19:14-15; Mk 16:12; Mt 28:16-17; Lk 24:13-16. What do you notice in all these texts? Why is that significant?
4. What is the significance of John writing that the net wasn't torn despite the large catch of fish? How does this demonstrate this is a work of Jesus not the apostles?
5. What does Jesus say love for Him looks like? What are those who love Him told to do? Is that only Peter or do all disciples have a role here? Peter said "Lord, you know everything." Why is this a significant issue?
6. Why does Jesus ask Peter 3 times "Do you love me?" Given the final prophecy, what else might be involved in Jesus' repeated query? If following Jesus involves suffering, how do we offer the grace & love of Christ knowing the journey is hard?
