

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Matthew 8:23-27 & John 20:30-31. What strikes you as you read?
2. Read Mt 8:14-22 for the context of this event. Having seen what the disciples just saw, why are they afraid now? How is fear a part of your life? (be honest ;-)) What do you do about it when it shows up?
3. Are faith & fear opposites? Can faith or should faith ever include fear? How did the disciples react to this astonishing sequence of events? Why is their next question an excellent one? What did they learn about the character & identity of Jesus?
4. Considering the history of God's people (God parting the Red Sea & Jordan River) what might this miracle have revealed about Jesus? How is your belief in the identity of Jesus critical to your ability to trust that He intends to care for you?
5. Read Mt 8:28-34. What does this add to your understanding of Jesus? How does his victory in the present time lead to confidence in his victory in your future? How does his resurrection give greater witness to his power to protect you? From what storms, demons, threats or dead-ends do you need Jesus to protect you?
