

## let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Luke 1:5-25 & 67-75. What strikes you as you read?
2. If an angel were to appear to you, what prayer would want answered? Why is Zechariah doubtful? Have you ever needed to believe the improbable or impossible?
3. Are there times when it seems God has forgotten about you & your struggles? Why might Zechariah feel that way? What reassurances does he receive from this vision? Describe a time you felt God working powerfully in you? How did that turn out?
4. God's answer to their prayers took a long time. How might their years of "disgrace" & disappointment prepared them for raising John, & preparing for his ministry?
5. How is obedience linked to faith? How do you see that in Zechariah's response & in his "silence?" When John is born, Zechariah's first words are praise. To what do you feel God calling you to trust & obey? What are you praising God for today?
6. If you were asked by a child what this part of the Christmas narrative was about, what would you say? Practice that answer on someone this week.
