

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Mark 10:35-45. What strikes you as you read?
2. Also, please read Mk 10:28-34. What part(s) of Jesus' previous teaching could have prompted James & John to make their requests? The literal translation of their request is, "whatever we ask of you." What might your life be like now if Jesus "did whatever you asked of Him" during the last year?
3. Compare their request, vs 37, with what Jesus says in vs 38 & 39. What do they not yet understand about Jesus' glory? What does their response (v. 39a) reveal?
4. What are your spiritual aspirations for 2021? Have you shared with Jesus what you would like Him to accomplish in your life & ministry? Are you asking Him to do great things in & through you? Why or why not? Is asking for Jesus to work mightily through you the same as or different from what James & John asked? How?
5. How does servanthood result in greatness? How does this inspire & challenge you? Have you asked Jesus to point you to a place or person to serve this week? What was his answer? What are you going to do?
6. Jesus served by giving his life as a "ransom" for the debt of sin we could not pay. With whom can you share that good news this week?
