let’s TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Mark 16:1-8 & Isaiah 25:6-9. What strikes you as you read?
2. Share a time you felt you had a fresh start or were renewed some way. How could Jesus’ resurrection renew you on a regular basis?
3. Why did the women visit the tomb? What does their action indicate? Why does the angel single out Peter as the one who is especially to be told about Jesus’ resurrection?
4. Despite every prediction Jesus made regarding his resurrection, the women went to the tomb assuming Jesus was still there. Are there any promises God has made to you in which you lack confidence or faith? Are there any areas of your life that reflect unbelief in what God has said He will do?
5. Why do you think the women told no one, even after being told to do so? What conclusions can we reach from the fact that the disciples were slow to believe the truth of the resurrection? Read the rest of Mark 16. In every gospel what is Jesus’ final command to his followers? How well are you obeying that command?
6. How would you explain to a non-Christian the importance of the resurrection? What impact does the resurrection of Christ have on how you face life? How can you share that with someone who doesn’t believe? What scriptures would you point to?
