

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Acts 3:1-16. What do you see here that catches your attention?
2. When was a time you asked for something, but got something better instead? Recount the actions of Peter in verses 3–7. What details does Luke give to let us know that this is a miracle?
3. What was the reaction of the crowd? What possible misunderstanding of the miracle on the crowd's part did Peter anticipate? From verse 12 to the end of the chapter, Peter speaks to the crowd about Jesus. Looking at verses 13–15, contrast the titles Peter uses to designate Jesus with the horrendous ways the people treated him. What "excuse" do they have [read to vs 17]? Is that really an excuse? Why/not?
4. Read the healing account in Lk 7:1-10. How is faith active in this event as well?
5. Peter & John brought a "blessing" to this lame man & the "blessing" of the Good News to those who heard their message. God is good & seeks to extend that good TO & ultimately THROUGH us. How can you be an instrument of God's blessing & an assurance of healing in Christ this week?
