2. Have you ever felt like you received a specific direction from the Holy Spirit? What did you do? How did that circumstance turn out? Would you do that again?
3. Why might Philip have been nervous speaking to this ranking Ethiopian governmental official? Is there anyone to whom you would be nervous witnessing?
4. Consider today's theme verse. How you would share the good news of Jesus beginning with the Old Testament? How much do you attend to the Old Testament as a Christian today? What part does the Old Testament have in your life?
5. Who in your life models obedience to God, regardless of circumstances or result? How might you imitate them in your life? Where could you start?
6. Why is the Ethiopian official so excited to be baptized? To what do you attribute his joy following his baptism? Do you share that same enthusiasm? Why/not?
7. With whom can you share the good news of Jesus this week as the Holy Spirit leads you into the encounters you have?
