1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Acts 15:1-21. What do you see here that catches your attention?
2. What about the "church" as you know it makes it difficult for people not-yet-attached to Jesus to become his followers? How can you become a "clearer of the way?"
3. What's the issue in Antioch? How did Paul & Barnabas counter the other teachers?
4. How does adding anything to the gospel really take away from it? Does true salvation require any works to BE saved? Does it require any works to STAY saved? What is the one essential in the gospel?
5. How would you explain Peter's claim in vs 11 that "by grace" we are saved?
6. What is the purpose of the law? Is anyone made righteous by keeping the law? What does the law do? What term does Peter use to describe the law?
7. If the law was no longer a first step to salvation, what was the purpose of the requirements of vs 20? How are those uniquely pagan behaviours to be set aside for new life in Christ? Read Col 3:9-12, Rom 13:14 & Gal 3:27. Ask the Holy Spirit to re-dress you in the likeness of Jesus this week as you offer his love to others.
