

let's TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read Nehemiah 4:1-23. What do you see here that catches your attention?
2. How did Sanballat, Tobiah & the others react to the work on the wall? Why do you think they were so immediately opposed? What 'weapons' are used here against the work? What does Nehemiah use to defend what God's people are doing?
3. What is his prayer? What do you think of his prayer? How would it feel to pray as Nehemiah did here?
4. Why could they make such quick progress on the wall? Why was this important based on what happens next? (vss 7-8) How is this escalation met by the builders?
5. The next threat/attack is internal. What is it? Have you ever experienced that attack on your faithful work for God? How did you overcome it, or did it overcome you?
6. How does Nehemiah continue to reveal his complete devotion dependence on God? If someone were to observe your life like the other workers saw Nehemiah, what would they see in your devotion & dependence?
7. Who needs to see the life of Jesus & the promises of God at work in you this week?
