2. When have you been in an uncomfortable or awkward situation that you wanted to immediately flee? How did you deal with that circumstance? What happened?
3. How did the demon-possessed girl negatively impact Paul's ministry? According to verse 19, why did the masters of the slave-girl get angry with Paul & Silas? What was the motivation behind their anger? Is that understandable? How would you have reacted? Why do you think that?
4. How do you think the slave girl felt after she was set free? How do you think the jailer felt while he had Paul & Silas as prisoners? What about when he had them in his home?
5. How do you see God at work in this text? How is that consistent with everything else we've seen in the book of Acts? To what challenge does that call you to accept?
6. How does studying this account equip you with boldness & the word of the good news to share the message of Christ with someone this week? Will you do that?
