

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/lows. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-15. What strikes you as you read?
2. What is the promise of small things sown in hope? What is God's intended outcome for his people? (clue: don't say 'heaven') When does God's kingdom become most evident in our lives? What would stop that from happening in a person?
3. For what purpose does God bless his people? How does generosity effect righteousness, & the ever-widening circles of people giving thanks to God?
4. How is generosity contagious? Why do you think it is like that? How does generosity build up the unity, strength, effectiveness, joy & impact of God's people?
5. How would a failure in the grace of generosity lead to a failure in a church's mission to reach the lost? When a congregation falters in its mission to reach the lost, how might an increase in its generosity reverse that trend?
6. To whom will you commit mutual accountability in growing in the grace of giving? With whom, outside the body of Christ, can you share that joy so they can thank God?
