

TALK

1. Gather in the name of the Father, Son & Holy Spirit. Share your highs/low. Read Psalm 8 & Matthew 6:25-34. What strikes you as you read?
2. What mood do you hear in the Psalm? How does it compare to Ps 103 from last week? Thomas Carlyle said, "Wonder is the basis of worship; worship is transcendent wonder." Is that true? How is that the case for you?
3. Read Matthew 21:15-16. How does Jesus use this passage to affirm the truth of Psalm 8:2?
4. David considers the "distance" between God's greatness/glory and frail fleeting humanity. What might that cause some to think about human life? How does David counter that argument straightaway?
5. What is God's role for humans? What does it mean to "be in charge of/have dominion over" the world God made? As a Christian, what is a suitable attitude to have towards God's creation? How do you live that out?
6. How can you communicate to someone who may not know it, that God indeed has a love and care for them we will never fully understand? Pray for that opportunity.
